Principal's Message

Welcome back to our students, staff and families for Term Three.

We have had a fantastic start to the term. Students are happy to be back at school and have worked incredibly hard from day one. We are absolutely focussed on the teaching and learning program for term 3 with less disruptions than we experienced in term 2.

The school captains and I am currently working with the Yarriam-black Shire to erect a school bollard display in the main street of Yaapeet. The students completed a diagram of the plan and we have submitted this to the shire for their approval. The shire are happy to support this project and will install the bollards once completed. It is exciting to think our wonderful school will be represented in the main street of this town for all visitors to see.

The refurbishment of the ART room learning space may be delayed due to the current restrictions in Greater Melbourne. I am waiting to here from VSBA in regards to a new date. We are happy to wait for this wonderful project to be completed as we feel very lucky to have this work carried out by Department of Education and Training (DET).

This week I attended Beulah PS as one of the challenge partners for their school review. It was a great experience to be a part of, especially as we are currently preparing for our own school review, now planned for Term 1 in 2021. I now have a much deeper understanding of the whole process. I will also be attending BPS next Thursday.

Due to current DET Guidelines, Professional Development (PD) sessions for staff will be conducted via Webex Meetings during Term 3. Our Southern Mallee Cluster events are also being reviewed for term three. We are extremely fortunate to be able to use technology to continue our own professional development and to connect with our cluster and network teams.

We have two approved curriculum days scheduled for this term. Friday 28th August, 2020. Staff will be working through the review process where we will be making decisions and uploading evidence to support the Framework for Improving Student Outcomes (FISO) dimensions. Monday 31st August will be used for Term 4 Teaching and Learning planning and setting up online assessment programs.

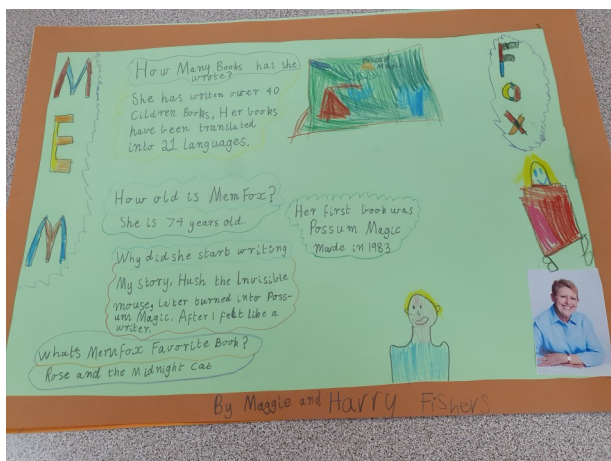
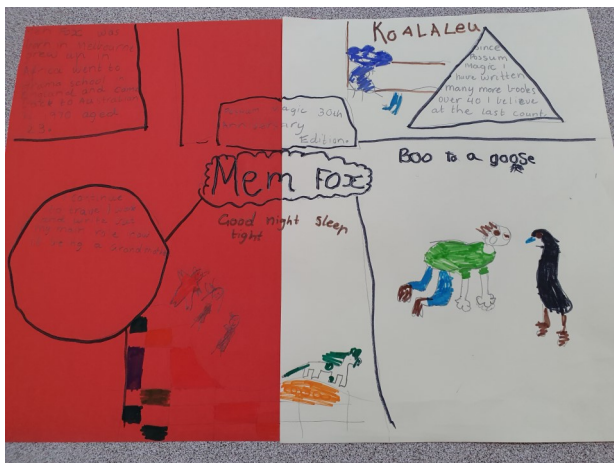
